Discussion Questions

1. What is the kingdom of God? What is your kingdom? How do you align the two?
2. What is discipleship and why is it important? (Hint: it's learning to live like Jesus.)
3. *"Transformation begins when God makes up there come down here, first in me, my mind and body."* Why do you think His kingdom must come first before transformation can happen? Why does transformation need to happen first in you?
4. What do you think about John's examples of the kingdom coming down here, when you resist sin and do the right thing, or you give sacrificially, or do good in any way? Do you see how you are living in the kingdom when that happens?
5. *"Set your mind on acts of moral beauty."* How does that thought of setting your mind on acts of moral beauty strike you? Why do you think doing that would be good? Where else could you be setting your mind?
6. What is your takeaway from this session?
